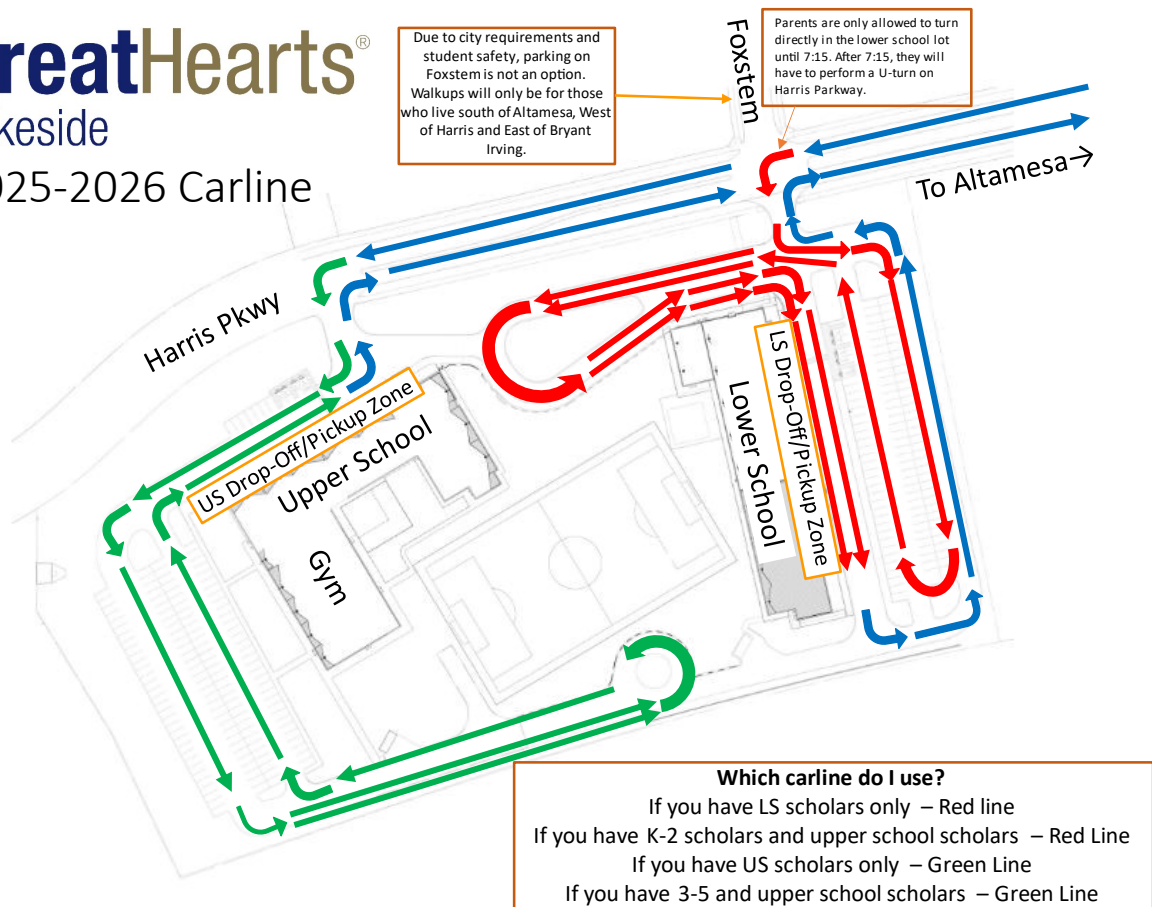

### **Morning Drop-Off and Afternoon Pick-Up**

Due to city requirements and student safety, parking on Foxstem is not an option. Cars may also not line up on Harris **before 7:00 AM and 3:00 PM. This will be enforced by a police officer.**

The city has mandated that officers issue tickets to any vehicles on Harris Parkway that are stopped or standing and have the opportunity to move forward in any traffic lane. Vehicles that are parked or stopped off the roadway will also be ticketed.

In the state of Texas, cell phones are not to be used while operating a motor vehicle, including in school lots. Please stick to the traffic guidelines to maximize safety, hospitality, and respect of others.

Walk-up is not available to all families. A provision will be made for families who live in **Tavolo Park**. These families will need to sign a waiver for their scholar to walk off-campus (more information to come).

### **Morning Drop-Off**

The security gate will be open at **6:45 AM** for morning drop-off. To minimize traffic disruption, scholars will only be walked across Harris Parkway at **7:15 AM, 7:30 AM, and 7:40 AM.**

### **Afternoon Pick-Up**

This year, we will be implementing wave times for afternoon pick-up. Please follow your wave times and do not arrive before your wave time. **The wave timing is designed to decrease your wait time. GHLS now has over 1400 students. Each vehicle that arrives before the assigned wave time will add an unnecessary number of vehicles to the parking lot and therefore hold up traffic.** Wave times work best when everyone in our community abides by them. **If you arrive before your appropriate wave time, you will be asked to leave the lot and re-queue in line.**

Please be reminded that all students that are not signed up for our After-School Program must be picked up **no later than 4:10 PM** each day. Any child who has not been picked up by that time

will be signed into our **After School Program** for their safety and supervision. Please note that a **late fee of \$1.00 per minute** will be charged beginning at **4:11 PM**. We understand that delays can happen, and we thank you in advance for planning accordingly to avoid any additional fees. Our goal is to ensure every child remains safe and accounted for after dismissal.

**Student drivers** will be dismissed promptly at **3:40 PM** to ensure they can safely leave campus safely before car line starts.

#### Upper School Wave Times

First Wave - Families with **9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade Scholars w/ siblings** - 3:40 PM - 3:55 PM

Second Wave - Families with **6<sup>th</sup> thru 8<sup>th</sup> grade Scholars w/siblings** - 3:45 PM - 4:05 PM

Third Wave - Families with **Upper School Scholars Only** - 4:00 PM - 4:10 PM

#### What line will you use?



If you only have  
**upper school  
scholars** in the car use  
the **green line**.

If you only have  
**lower school scholars** in  
the car use the **red line**.

What If You Have Both?!

*Go by the youngest scholar in the car*

**GREEN  
LINE**

If the *youngest* scholar  
in the car is  
**3rd - 10th grade,**  
use the **green line**.

3rd, 4<sup>th</sup>, and 5th grade scholars will  
walk to the lower school building.

**RED  
LINE**

If the *youngest* scholar  
in the car is  
**Kinder – 2nd grade,**  
use the **red line**.

Upper school scholars will walk to  
the upper school building.
